Support 4 Fud

In June Fud was presented with his new electric wheelchair thanks to the fundraising efforts of <u>Chi Samui</u> and <u>Kalara Group</u>. Under the care and guidance of Smile Coconut Healthcare Fud spent 3 days 3 nights in Nathon Hospital undergoing Bisphosphonate Therapy: essential treatment for weak bones. Next treatment due in October.



Food 4 Life

We began our Food4Life appeal back in April 2020 to buy essential supplies for families left without any means of earning a living due to the economic collapse caused by Covid-19. Today, thanks to generous support we are sill supplying eggs, rice, noodles, cooking oil and tins of sardines to over 300 families every month. In June we had 8 delivery days with 325 families supplied with 1.5 tonnes of rice plus the usual oodles of noodles, eggs & sardines. With special thanks to the donations made by:-
