Defibs 4 Samui

We are deeply humbled by the generosity and kindness of Asajan อัศจรรย์
Festival. Donations from vendors and visitors to their last event has allowed us to purchase another defibrillator for Samui Emergency Services
Defibrillation plus CPR increases survival rate from heart attack to over 70%.
Defibs4Samui aims to ensure all 15 public emergency vehicles on the island are equipped with this small but essential piece of equipment.

Each defib costs 40,000 THB. With Christmas coming up there's no better way to show that you care. If you would like to have a defib dedicated to you, a

Community Outreach Service - Captain

This sweet child is named Captain. He showed no abnormal behaviour until after a regular vaccination at 2 months of age. After that he became agitated and at 4 months he had a spasm in one arm. Now at age 4 he has very limited control of his movements and unable to sit up or stand. Cerebral Palsy is suspected but MRI and TT scans in Bangkok have so far failed to confirm a diagnosis. With financial support from Rotary and other kind folks on Samui

and overseas we will set up a regular schedule of physiotherapy, buy necessary equipment and investigate what further medical interventions may be appropriate led by Smile Coconut Healthcare

Learning Center for Magical Autistic Children ศูนย์เรียนรู้ เด็กออทิสติก กับสิ่งมหัศจรรย์

Learning Center for Magical Autistic Children (MAC) is a not-for-profit cooperative of parents and carer givers looking after children with autism and other learning difficulties. The Center receives no financial support from local government.

Through Rotary donations we provide (1) financial support for two care workers (2) cover children's daily transportation costs to the learning center (3) supply food for daily lunches, often the only hot cooked meal of the day (4) arrange outdoor activities for exercise and well being (5) encourage others to share their skills and knowledge with the children and if appropriate with the Thai staff. (6) fundraise for building maintenance and to supply essential items like furniture, fans, learning materials etc.
