Food 4 Life

This emergency relief program was started as a result of the collapse of international tourism caused by the Covid pandemic. On an island so heavily dependent on tourism tens of thousands of people suddenly found themselves without the means to earn a living. Many returned to family on the mainland but those with nowhere else to go faced a dire situation.

We are immensely grateful and humbled by all the donations we received large

and small from people around the world and in total raised over one million Thai Baht (over 30,000 USD). Special thanks goes to:-

Nearly 400 5kg bags of rice were distributed every month last year (an incredible 24,000 kg!) together with other essential provisions like instant noodles, cooking oil and tins of sardines. Two distributions each week making 104 deliveries in 2022. None of this would have been possible without the dedication, strong arms and sturdy wheels of Brent from <u>Trash Heroes Samui</u>

We are happy to report that this program is now closed as tourism is slowly but steadily improving.



Defibs 4 Samui

In April 2022 we became aware that there was a lack of Defibrillators (AEDs) in public service emergency vehicles. This small but essential piece of equipment can increases survival rate from a heart attack to over 70% when used in conjunction with CPR.

In June we started our new campaign to fundraise for the Heartsine Samaritan PAD 350P AED which is fully maintained in Thailand and comes with dual language support. Last year we were able to donate 4 Defibs with the generous support of the following:-

One more Defib is on its way. Another 5 are needed for Koh Samui and Koh Phangan. Each defib costs 40,000 THB (approx. 1,200 USD) If you would like to have a defib dedicated to you, a loved one or your business please get in touch.



Community Outreach Service

In 2022 we were able to reach out to more families and individuals who have particular challenging life circumstances. Once again only made possible by the kind donations from resorts like <u>Chi Samui</u>, Rotary Clubs and individual supporters on Samui and around the world.

While Samui is a wonderful place to live and visit, specialist medical treatment is hard to find for people with special needs like down's syndrome, epilepsy or brittle bone disorder. Together with Rotarian Mira Beer and her team at <u>Smile</u> <u>Coconut Healthcare</u> we continue to find the best possible solutions whether treatment on Samui or travel to Bangkok or elsewhere.



Support 4 Autism Project

Covid restrictions ebbed and flowed with the tide throughout 2022 but for most of this time small groups of children were allowed to gather in well ventilated and outdoor environments. The Learning Center for Magical Autistic Children and the Rotary Club were able to continue supporting the special needs children and their families.

Rotary extends in heartfelt thanks to all the resorts who (while suffering from lack of tourism) were still willing to welcome and host the children with use of pool and playground activities and lunch. Too many to mention but include Royal Beach Samui, U Samui, Tembo Beach Club, Shiva Samui Beach Club, Chi Samui, Lanna Samui, Melia Koh Samui and Kimpton Kitalay.

Rotary began its Support4Autism Project in 2020 but has been organising weekly swimming pool sessions since 2018. In 2022 we expanded our support - thanks to kind donations and Rotarians time - to help with staff expenses; daily art activities; children's transportation and daily lunches. We are looking forward to 2023 with new support and collaboration from <u>Windfield International</u> <u>School</u>
