This month we were pleased to present our 6th Defib to the Samui Emergency Services thanks to a generous donation from <u>The Rotary Club of South West</u> <u>Rocks Australia</u>

Defibrillation plus CPR increases survival rate from heart attack to over 70%. Our Defibs4Samui campaign aims to ensure all public emergency vehicles on the islands of Samui and Phangan are equipped with this small but essential piece of equipment. Swim 4 Life

Child water safely and drowning prevention on Samui Who's the students now?

Four Rotary members travelled to Phuket to undergo an intense 2 day course in combating hydrophobia and swimming teaching techniques. A hit squad from Swim Australia flew in especially for the event which was attended by Rotary Club members from Royal Hua Hin and Phuket, Patong Beach. A previous course was held in Chiang Mai and the Swim Australia team were off next to Cambodia. The initiative comes from a new <u>Global Water Safety and</u> <u>Drowning Prevention Rotary Club</u> which aims to put a stop to the terrible statistics of child drowning in many countries in S.E.Asia

All Rotary members survived and passed the course. You are safe in our hands now.
