Swim 4 Life Project

Let's work together to stop child drowning related deaths in Thailand

มาร่วมอาสาด้วยกันเพื่อลดอัตราการสูญเสียเด็กจากการจมน้ำในประเทศไทย

2020 the World Health Organization reported that Thailand is still "number one" for child deaths by drowning in ASEAN. In fact, the WHO says that the country's child death by drowning rate is twice as high as the world's average! Help us reverse this trend which has only got worse during the years of Covid lockdowns and school closures.

With no public swimming pool on Samui there is little opportunity for children in local schools to learn basic water safety. We are blessed with beautiful beaches but without swimming and safety classes, the sea is as much a hazard as a blessing for local children.

It costs just 2,000 THB (aprox. 58USD, 86AUD, 54EUR, 46GBP) to put a child through our 12 week drowning prevention program Swim4Life. Please follow the link to donate today.

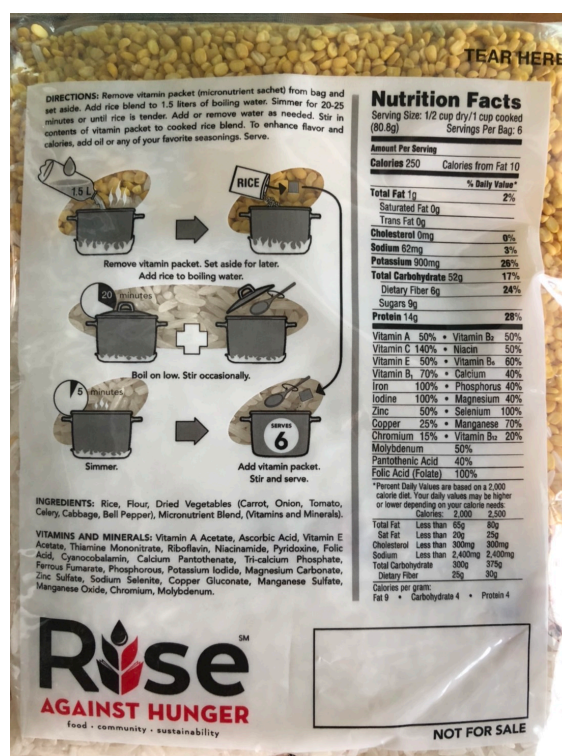
Food 4 Life Project - Rise Against Hunger

Having read about our Food4Life project our friends at RC Plutaluang offered us 9 boxes of fortified meals to help families still recovering from the effects of the Covid-related lockdowns and business closures.

Each box contains 36 sealed packs so a total of 324 packs which we will be

distributing to the most needy very soon.


Thinking about our local environment
