#### **Defibs Save Lives**

Last month one of our defibs was used to save a life. Well done Samui Emergency Services who were first on the scene and used the AED to save the life of a male tourist. The patient was then transferred to Bangkok Hospital for further treatment. The defib was donated by Adam Gale of <u>Live Play Work Australia</u> in November 2022.

After use the defib needs a quick re-furbishment and replacement battery pack. Rotary takes care of that and provides a replacement defib to ensure the Emergency Services are always fully prepared. The replacement defib was one of 3 new defibs donated by Rotary Club Hong Kong South. Thank you

## Swim4Life and Life Guard Training 3-5 June

Thanks to the generous support of the <u>International School of Samui (ISS)</u> our Swim4Life drowning prevention program will re-start in early June. Drowning is the third leading cause of accidental death worldwide and low-to-middle income countries account for over 90% of this. Sadly children up to the age of 14 are

Swim4Life will kick off with an international life saving course at ISS open to all aged 18+. The internationally certified training company First Aid Training Bangkok will be coming to run the course and have reduced the price to 9,500 THB in support of the Rotary project. The course is open to anyone who is a competent swimmer.
