The party you rave at could be your last



Their main ambulance had a failed AC in the patient treatment area that needed 50,000 THB to repair. The ambulance has no windows and poor ventilation which in this climate increases patient risks and decreases care outcomes. The repair bill was covered 50/50 by our Rotary Club and our friends at <u>Live Play Work</u>
